MIXED ANIMAL VETERINARIAN- PLATTE SD

Mixed animal veterinarians wanted for a full or part time position in Platte, SD. Central Dakota Animal Clinic is a busy mixed animal practice in south central South Dakota. Our practice is comprised of approximately 60% beef cattle, 20% equine, and 20% Small Animal. The practice includes 2 veterinarians, 1 technician, 1 assistant, 1 receptionist, and 3 part time kennel attendants.

We are seeking 1 veterinarian with beef cattle interest and 1 veterinarian with equine interest or a combination of bovine, equine, and small animal. All sectors are growing with increased demand for services so the position can be tailored towards your interests. The bovine side of the practice is mostly cow/calf with a few farmer feeder feedyards. Year round we perform pregnancy diagnosis via ultrasound, breeding soundness exams, calf processing, and routine OB work. The busiest times are spring and fall but remains steady year-round. Herd sizes range from 100-1200 head and are comprised of hobby herds to industry leading seed stock producers. The clinic has a haul-in facility for processing, lameness evaluations, and OB work. Fully stocked vet truck and hydraulic chutes are available for work in the field.

The equine side of the practice sees routine wellness/medicine, surgery, dentals, lameness, pre-purchase exams, joint injections, and repro including breeding and foal-outs. A separate facility is maintained for equine work with a climate-controlled exam room and hospitalization stall as well as a climate-controlled stall barn. Also in the equine facility is a padded surgery suite with hydraulic hoist and lift table. We also maintain an in-house coggins testing lab, running approximately 1,800 EIA tests per year.

The small animal side of the practice stays busy with routine medicine and surgery, orthopedic surgery including lateral suture for CCL repair as well as bone pinning, and canine reproductive services including artificial insemination and semen collection and freezing.

The practice utilizes Idexx Neo software, Idexx analyzers, and digital radiography. Hospitalization kennels are utilized for in-patient use and we have a boarding facility with 11 kennels. A separate calf ward is utilized in the spring for neonatal calf medicine. 95% of the bovine OB work and Equine cases are hauled to our facility.

Platte, SD is a thriving town in south central South Dakota, 15 miles east of the Missouri River. Fishing, hunting, and outdoor recreation opportunities are endless. Many of the beef clients have their own working facilities. The small animal work consists mostly of dogs and cats. We do spays, neuters, declaws, amputations, “c” sections, bladder stone removals and various other kinds of surgeries. We have an Idexx blood chemistry machine, and a Heska hematology machine. We also have a DR wizard digital x ray machine. There are a small number of sheep, goats, horses and chickens. It truly is a mixed animal practice. We have a nice group of young farmers in our area. The practice is located 30 miles from Sioux Falls. The small animal component could be expanded greatly. Honesty and integrity and a healthy respect for the clients have been integral in building this practice. Relationships have been built and valued from both
